

Standard First Aid CPR AED Level C

The Standard First Aid CPR AED Level C course is a comprehensive program designed to meet the needs of the workplace. This course is approved by the OH&S regulatory body. Course content includes key areas required by workplace regulators, including:

- Emergency Scene Management
- Shock, Fainting and Unconsciousness
- Bleeding and Wounds
- Asthma and Allergies
- Head, Spinal and Pelvic Injuries
- Diabetic Emergencies
- Seizures
- Respiratory and Cardiovascular Emergencies,
- And more...

Full course teaches learners to promptly recognize several life-threatening emergencies, give high-quality chest compressions, deliver appropriate ventilations, and provide early use of an AED. It includes adult, child, and infant rescue techniques. The Standard First Aid course includes realistic scenarios and hands on practice. This course completion time varies depending on class sizes. It can take up to 16 hours to complete the content with larger groups.

Cost: \$130

Renewal course this is a fast-paced course for experienced First Aid providers able to demonstrate knowledge through written and skills assessment. This is a concentrated one day course taking approximately 6-8 hours to complete. Renewal is required every 3 years.
